

WDBS Disciplinary Procedure

Upon entering a WDBS event players agree to be bound by the current WDBS Standard Conditions of Entry, from the point of event entry until 7 days after the conclusion of that event.

In the event of any alleged breach of the Conditions reported by the Tournament Director or any other party, WDBS will have two options available as follows:

- 1) To issue a warning letter to the player as to the alleged breach
- 2) To refer the matter to the WPBSA

Should a referral to the WPBSA be made, the WPBSA will then formally write to the player, who will have 14 days to respond. Following the receipt of a response, the WPBSA will then have the following options available:

- No further action
- Warning Letter
- Formal warning
- Suspended fine
- Fine (maximum £1,500)

If, in the view of the WPBSA the alleged breach is deemed so serious that it merits a greater sanction, the matter will be considered in full by the WPBSA Disciplinary Committee.
